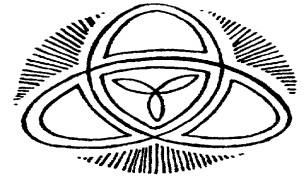

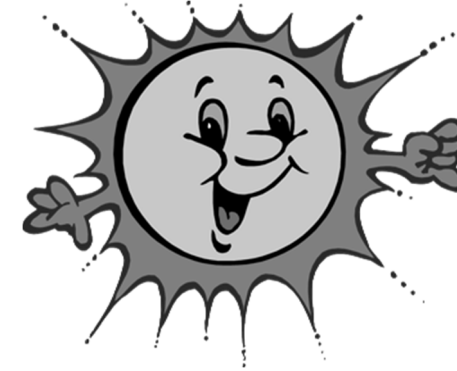

**REFLECTION**

In today's gospel, we see Jesus in his hometown of Nazareth. As was the night of every devout Jew, he gave the homily in the Synagogue on a Sabbath day, The townspeople were amazed - they think they know who Jesus is and because they know him, they refuse to accept him.

The same thing can happen to us. God is constantly speaking to us through the people we know; through the things that happen to us. Again and again we do not recognise God's voice, because he is speaking through someone we know well - or someone we do not like - or someone who is a total stranger.

Yet everyone of us, because of our Baptism, is called to be a prophet - to spread the good news, in our families, our workplace, among our friends. Whatever is happening, we have to proclaim and defend truth, love, justice, freedom, people's rights and dignity. Let us not be discouraged by our shortcomings. God wants us to be his instruments, and he will stand by us, and give us the grace we need, when ever we need it.
