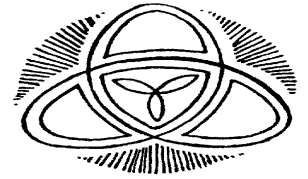

**REFLECTION**

In today's Gospel , the Apostles receive their mission from Jesus. He tells them to go out, two by two, and drive out "unclean" spirits. We cannot follow Jesus' instructions literally, although the ideal certainly remains in place. Even so, the Gospel is saying two things to us. Each Christian is called , not only to be a disciple - one who hears, who accepts and carries out the teaching of Jesus in his or her life - but to be an apostle - one who is not only a follower, but also are evangelise - one who shares with others his/her experience of knowing Jesus - spelt out for us in today's second reading. We share ,not just words, or ideas, or doctrine, but our experience of God and Jesus.

Because we have been baptised, Jesus is calling us, in our working and living environment, to evangelise, to invite people to know him. And then, in the end, those are influence will, hopefully, become the evangeliser of others. That is how the mustard seed grows into a large tree.
