REFLECTION

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. The Trinity is one of the most basic doctrines of our Christian faith. When we enter the Church, we are baptised "in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit." It forms part of the very earliest teaching of the Church. It can be found in the letters of Paul, which were written before the gospels. "There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit gives them. There are different ways of serving, but the same Lord is served. There are different abilities to perform service, but the same God gives ability to everyone for their service. "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all". This is a greeting often used at the beginning of the Eucharist but is in fact the closing words of Paul's second Letter to the Corinthians. There is one body and one spirit, just as there is one hope to which God has called you. There is one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism, there is one God and Father of all, who is Lord of all, works through all, and is in all.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS 2018

The GDPR focuses on the collection, storage, processing, and destruction of Personal Data. Personal Data is different to general data, or information which is held on a computer filing system. Personal Data is information about a living individual who can be identified from information that is collected or stored.

In our parishes, we do hold Personal Data for example from the census recently taken, any rotas we might have, Marriage details, Baptism details, all these details are kept locked in the safe or locked in the office.
