## REFLECTION

"This Law that I enjoin on you today is not beyond your strength or beyond your reach.....It is very near to, it is in your mouth and in your heart for your observance." Deut. 30.

God's law is not so mysterious and remote; it is not in the sky or across the sea, but is already in our mouths and hearts. To love God with everything we have, and to love our neighbour as our selves.

We have difficulty loving God because we live in a world "filled with lights contrary to the light of God's truth. "The Lord hears the poor, " but our world scorns the poor. Our God makes peace through the blood of his cross" while our world tries to make peace

We have difficulty loving our neighbour because we do not understand "neighbour" as Jesus did.

Neighbour means people we like, people who are on our side, who work for a living, and who mind their own business. Jesus redefines neighbour as the hated stranger who is down and out, challenging us to stop what we are doing and care for their need! Jesus is teaching his followers to see the ditch as God's dwelling place: to love one's neighbour as defined by Jesus is to love God.

'One's neighbour is not only a human being with his or her own rights and a fundamental equality with everyone else, but becomes the living image of God the Father, redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ and placed under the permanent action of the Holy Spirit. One's neighbour must therefore be loved, even if an enemy, with the same love which the Lord loves him or her.'
